### **Preamble**

This Statement of Work accompanies an Agreement that has been executed by the parties. All statements of fact contained in this Statement of Work are subject to the terms and conditions set forth in such Agreement. The terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement control in the event of any inconsistency between such terms and conditions and the matters set forth in this Statement of Work.

## 1.0 Project Background

Developer agrees to design, develop, and publish for Client a public website which will serve to assist Client in the marketing of their products and/or services. The range and limits of this Project are to include Developer's completion of the products and services listed below, as described.

## 2.0 Content to be Provided by Client

- All content (data, information, text, media, etc.) that is marked with a dagger (†) must be provided by Client during the development process.
- Developer will proof-read and edit the content as necessary. This service is provided on a "best-effort" basis with no guarantee of accuracy or perfection. Client is solely responsible for proof-reading all content before the Project is published.
- Developer is not responsible for delays during the development process due to Client's delay in providing this content.

## 3.0 Internet Domain Name Registration

Client will register all domain names that are to be associated with this Project. Client is responsible for all fees associated with this process. This includes the following domain name(s):

## 4.0 Website Design

- **4.1** Developer will produce up to three (3) website design concepts for Client's review. Client must choose one (1) design concept which Developer will use to create a custom design template for the **Public Website (Frontend)** (item #6.0). Requests for additional design concepts must be authorized and billed separately.
- **4.2** Client may request reasonable revisions to the chosen design. Up to Ten (10) hours will be available for revisions to the chosen website design concept. Additional revisions must be authorized and billed separately.
- **4.3** Developer will produce a custom website design template including styles for the website elements listed below:
  - **4.3.1** Navigation (primary/secondary navigation, text links, buttons).
  - **4.3.2** Text elements (headings, subheadings, paragraphs, lists).
  - **4.3.3** Form elements (labels, hints, inputs, buttons).
  - **4.3.4** Media (photos, slideshows, Google Maps, iframes).
  - **4.3.5** AJAX-style popup windows

## 5.0 "Coming Soon" Web Billboard

Developer will design a basic "Coming Soon" web page based on Client's chosen website design concept and publish this page on Client's public web server to serve as a placeholder until the project is complete. This page will contain Client's logo (†), a brief description of Client's services (†), and basic contact information for Client (†).

## **6.0** Public Website (Frontend)

The following website content will be made available to the public via the Client's domain name(s).

## 6.1 Site-Wide Design Features

The following features will be available throughout the Project as described below:

### 6.1.1 Search Engine Optimization

Developer will provide "on-page" search engine optimization (SEO) in an effort to increase the likelihood of achieving favorable "organic" search engine placement. On-page optimization includes:

- Basic research of popular keywords.
- Basic analysis of competing websites.
- Optimization of the following HTML tags:

  - <title>

  - Headings (<h1> <h6>)
- Development of sitemap document for search robots using the "Sitemap protocol".

Client understands that this service is provided on a best-effort basis with no guarantee of 100% compliance.

#### **6.1.3** General Features:

- Links to Client's web-based social networking pages (ie: Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Flickr, etc.) will be displayed on every page within the **Public Website (Frontend)** (item #6.0), where applicable.
- Interactive content will be provided wherever possible at Developer's discretion. This will include the use of AJAX technologies to improve navigation and usability while minimizing page refreshes and load-time to the end-user.
- Client's address (†) and telephone and fax number(s) will be displayed in the footer of every page.

#### 6.1.4 Website Security

Upon submission of a web form the form's contents will be validated for accuracy and security purposes. Upon successful validation the form contents will be forwarded to an e-mail address specified by Client and a confirmation will be displayed to the end-user. #### 6.6 Custom Error Documents

In the event that the end-user encounters an error while using the website, a custom error document will be displayed providing basic information about the error and suggestions for correcting the problem. The following default HTTP error documents will be replaced with their respective custom versions:

### 6.6.1 400 (Bad Request)

This error occurs when the end-user's request could not be understood by the server due to malformed syntax. The end-user will be instructed to change their request before trying again.

#### **6.6.2 401** (Unauthorized)

This error occurs when the end-user requests access to a password-protected area of the website without providing proper credentials. The **Sitemap** (item #6.5.3) will be included on this page in an attempt to redirect the end-user to the appropriate page.

#### 6.6.3 403 (Forbidden)

This error occurs when the end-user requests access to an area of the website that is strictly off-limits to any user. The **Sitemap** (item #6.5.3) will be included on this page in an attempt to redirect the end-user to the appropriate page.

#### 6.6.4 404 (File Not Found)

This error occurs when the end-user's request for a page is mistyped or when the requested page has been moved or deleted. The **Sitemap** (item #6.5.3) will be included on this page in an attempt to redirect the end-user to the appropriate page.

### 6.6.5 500 (Internal Server Error)

This error occurs when there is a problem with the programming of the website. In the event of this error a detailed report will be forwarded to Developer for review. The end-user will be informed that Developer is aware of the issue and will work to correct is as soon as possible. The end-user will then be instructed to try their request again later.

### **6.7** Revisions to the Public Website (Frontend)

Client may request reasonable revisions to the **Public Website (Frontend)** (item #6.0) after Client's first review of the Project. Up to Ten (10) hours will be available for revisions to the Project. Additional revisions must be authorized and billed separately.
